Process

Steps:

The presenter who deals with a new topic should incorporate the following four steps into his/her presentation:

1. **Experiencing:** why: examples the participants can identify themselves with, the past, motivation using stories, anecdotes, quotations
2. **Conceptualization:** what: data, facts, connections, statistics, research results, different evidence (sources, photos, suggestions, principles ...)
3. **Applying:** how could we reach it?: debate, case studies, demonstration, role-play, instructions ...
4. **Creating:** what if: future, steps to be taken, further options, plan, transfer to practice, summary ...
